

## **CAN I ENTER THIS IMAGE IN A BELMONT COMPETITION IN 2010?**

**These guidelines should be read in conjunction with the competition rules for 2010.**

### **MONTHLY COMPETITIONS – Prints or EDI**

Images that are completely new, or that are substantially different from images that you have entered in previous Belmont competitions, can be entered provided they meet all the rules (such as the special monochrome rules).

For all other images, if you answer YES to ANY of the following questions then the image CANNOT be entered in a monthly competition:

1. Has this image (or an image that is substantially the same) gained an award of Honours or a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> place in a monthly competition at Belmont (as a print or EDI) in any year?
2. Has this image (or an image that is substantially the same) been entered THREE times in a monthly competition at Belmont (as a print or EDI) in any category and in any year?
3. Has this image gained a Top 10 place in a PASOTY at Belmont (as a print or EDI) in any year?

### **IMAGE OF THE YEAR COMPETITION – Prints and Open EDI**

To be eligible for entry in the 2010 *Image of the Year* competition the image must have been entered in a monthly competition at Belmont during 2010.

However, if you answer YES to ANY of the following questions then the image CANNOT be entered in the *Image of the Year* competition:

1. Has this image had any changes made to it since the monthly competition in which it was last entered?
2. Do I intend to enter substantially the same image in a different category (print or EDI) in the *Image of the Year*?

### **IMAGE OF THE YEAR COMPETITION – Nature EDI and Altered Reality EDI**

As there is no monthly EDI category for Nature or Altered Reality then any image may be entered, excepting that if you answer YES to ANY of the following questions then the image CANNOT be entered in the *Image of the Year* competition:

1. Do I intend to enter substantially the same image in a different category (print or EDI) in the *Image of the Year*?
2. Has this image (or substantially the same image) gained a Top 10 place in a PASOTY at Belmont (as a print or EDI) in any year?
